NOTICE

All students of different Para Medical Courses, who are in 1st Year/2nd Year in various Medical Colleges/Government Institutions/Non-Government Affiliated Institutions, are hereby informed that Regular Examinations (Preliminary & Final) for 2021, both Theory and Viva, would be held tentatively on and from Monday, the 22nd November, 2021.

The salient features of the said Regular Examinations have been furnished as follows:-

- [1] Online Examinations would be arranged through TFH (Test from Home) Mode.
- [2] Theory Question Papers for all Para Medical Courses in each Term i.e. Preliminary and Final, would be of <u>Objective Type</u> consisting of 20 MCQs [with four options], 10 True/False, 10 Match the Column "A" with "B" and 10 Fill-in-the Blanks.
- [3] Total numbers of questions are 50, carrying 1 mark each with no choice or option, with duration of Examination 2 hours, and, it would be doubled to equate full marks of 100 in each Paper. Pass Marks would be 50 in each paper.
- [4] The Viva Examinations in each paper of each Para Medical Course, both Preliminary and Final, would be of 100 marks to be taken in one/two sittings or more (where number of students are more) with 10 Questions, and each question would carry 10 marks with duration of 10 minutes per student. Pass mark would be 50 in each paper.
- [5] The same mode of platform, which is used by the respective Institutes for "Online Classes", may be used for Viva Examinations.

It is also informed that arrangement of Offline Viva Examinations may be considered in case of normal situation turns up at the time of holding Examinations instead of pandemic situation.

- [6] There will be no Internal Assessment and restriction on Attendance in view of Pandemic situation caused by COVID-19.
- [7] Payment of Examination Fees amounting to Rs.500/- for issue of Admit Cards (For Private Institutions), and, payment of 2nd Year Course Fees of Rs.15,000/-, for all such students, who would be sent up for Final Examinations for this Year i.e. 2021 be charged as usual.
