ACADEMIC CALENDAR – 2026 for Diploma in Allied and Healthcare Courses

A. The under-mentioned Allied and Healthcare Courses, under the aegis of the State Medical Faculty of West Bengal, have to follow the Academic Calendar – 2026 as appended below for conduction of Final and Preliminary Examinations:-

2. Diploma in Dialysis Technique: Dialysis Technician Course
3. Diploma in Critical Care Technology: DCCT Course
4. Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology: DMLT (Tech) Course
5. Diploma in Perfusion Technology: DPFT Course
6. Diploma in Neuro Electro Physiology: DNEP Course
7. Diploma in Cath Lab Technology: DCLT Course
8. Diploma in Physiotherapy: DPT Course
9. Diploma in Radiotherapeutic Technology: DRT (Tech) Course
10. Diploma in Optometry with Ophthalmic Technique: D.OPT Course
11. Diploma in Diabetes Care Technology: DDCT Course
12. Diploma in Operation Theatre Technology: DOTT Course
13. Diploma in Electrocardiographic Technique: ECG Technician Course

Note:-

*** The session for Diploma in Allied and Healthcare Courses - 2025, of all Govt. Medical College & Hospitals/ Institutions, and, Non- Govt. Institutions commenced on and from 2nd December, 2025. Therefore, the Preliminary Examinations month would be decided in due course.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

In regarding **Internal Assessment** for Preliminary & Final Examination of 13 Diploma in Allied and Healthcare Courses for the year 2026:

1. The students who are due to sit for the Preliminary Examinations and Final Examinations in August, 2026, (tentatively) are required to undergo Internal Assessment at their respective Institute in each segment i.e. Theory/Practical/Oral & Practical, of any of the Allied and Healthcare Courses in which they are being taught.
2. The qualifying “Pass Mark” in Internal Assessment is 50% each in **Theory/Practical/Oral & Practical**.
3. The students, who would obtain the qualifying 50% or more marks in Internal Assessment, would need to be declared by the concerned Institute as “Passed”, and, names of such students are to be submitted in the prescribed Slip Rolls, issued by the Office of SMFWB, **within June, 2026** to enable the Office to issue Admit Cards in time for them.

The students who would not obtain the qualifying ‘Pass Marks’ in Internal Assessment, Admit Cards for them would not be sent by the Faculty Office.

4. Further to the above, Admit Cards to be issued to all such students subject to the fulfillment of the following two conditions:-
 - a. Students are required to obtain Pass Marks (50%) in Internal Assessment in each segment (Theory & Practical) of an Allied and Healthcare Course.
 - b. Students are required to **attain the minimum percentage in attendance, i.e., 75%** both in 1st year, and, 2nd year classes respectively.
 - i) However, students who have secured attendance **between 60% and 74%** are required to pay a **fine of Rs. 2000/-** along with the **examination fee of Rs. 800/-**-totaling **Rs. 2800/-**, to appear for the examinations at the Faculty Office.

- ii) Students with attendance percentage below 60% are not allowed to appear at the examinations.
5. In this context, it is to be noted that the Full Marks in each Theory Paper of each Allied and Healthcare Course would be 100, and, it would also be 100 in Oral/Practical/Oral & Practical. The Pass Mark is 50% both in Theory /Oral/Practical/Oral & Practical.
 6. The Oral and Practical Examinations shall be conducted within seven (07) days from the date of completion of the Theory Examinations.
 7. The Clinical Assessment Examinations relating to the D.OPT Final Part shall be conducted in offline mode by the respective institutions within fifteen (15) days from the date of completion of the Theory Examinations.

Supplementary Examination for all Allied and Healthcare Courses

Supplementary Examinations for Allied and Healthcare Courses would be held tentatively, within 2 (Two) months from the Date of Declaration of the results of the Regular Preliminary/Final Examinations.
